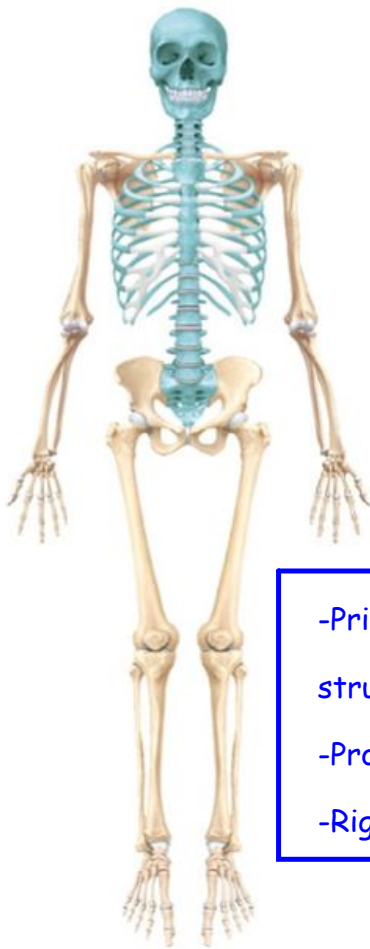
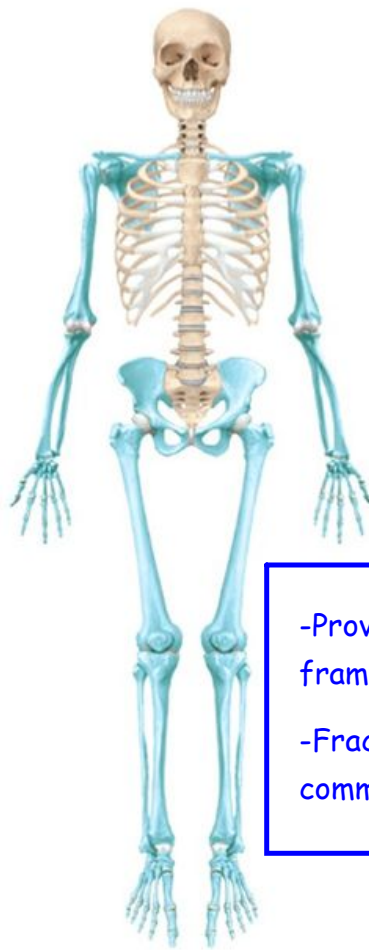


Axial skeleton

- Fractures more common, less serious

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
