"If Earth could change over time, could life change too?"




Idea #2: Jean Baptiste Lamarck

Species can evolve in one lifetime by selective using body parts


These acquired traits could be passed on

Lamarck's Giraffe


"Maybe this idea that living things can evolve isn't so crazy after all!"

If populations continue to grow unchecked, space will eventually run out




Most organisms don't survive and reproduce. Which individuals survive and why?
