1. Introduction

- a. State the subject (ex: By-catch is....)

- c. State the main point (why is it important ex: By-catch of shark related species is dangerous for fishermen and creates a threat to the population of....

2. Background Research

- a. Offer background information on the subject (This is the science! ex: 25% of the species of fish caught in the sport-halibut fishery are classified as by-catch.....)
- b. Discuss the causes of the problem, showing how these causes brought about the problem. (Ex: skates, rays, and dogfish are bottom dwelling species that will also bite hooks with bait targeting halibut...)

3. Describe the Project Plan:

- a. Identify the solution (Ex: By-catch from the sport halibut fishery can be reduced by...)
- b. Describe the plan's major and minor steps. (I will make fish hooks out of Neodymium that will deliver a slight electric shock to shark related species...)

4. Costs and Benefits

- a. Identify the cost of the project plan (and where money will come from remember, you can't spend more than \$50 of your own money)
- b. Describe how this will help benefit the community or area. (Eximprove sport fishing experience and grow economy)
- c. Identify the outcome (if this is done, then...If this is not done, then...)

5. Conclusion

- a. Restate the proposal's main point (the solution)
- b. Describe the next step (if you were to take your plan a step further, what could you do? Ex: Educate sport anglers with a class and give out fish hook samples.
